There are no simple answers; it all depends on how much you know before you go to a flight school. Learn this and more in my guide.

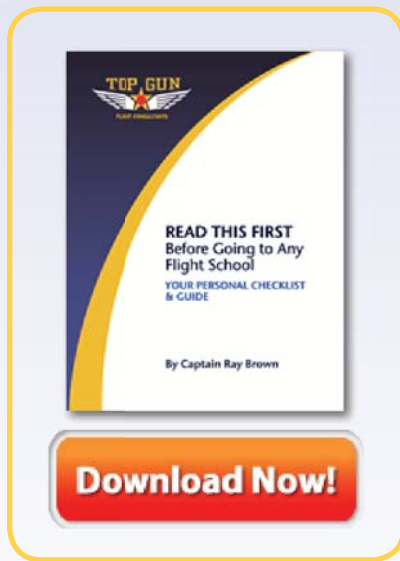
